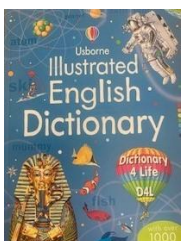
Class photographs will be taken on Monday 19th June. We are back in to full school uniform from this date [School uniform expectations](#) are available by clicking on this link.
